Boarding Requirements and Information

- 1.) All cats must have the required immunizations for boarding: **Rabies** and **FVRCP**. (KGVC can vaccinate while boarding if the vaccine is not current)
- 2.) All dogs must have the required immunizations for boarding: **Rabies, Bordetella, and DHLPP**. (KGVC can vaccinate while boarding if the vaccine is not current)
- 3.) All pets must have had a **fecal examination** for internal parasites within the last **6 months**. (KGVC can perform this test while boarding if the fecal exam is not current)
- 4.) Please be aware that for dogs in heat/intact males and females there is an \$11 charge per day in addition to the boarding per day charge.
- 5.) All clients are required to have read and signed the necessary boarding/release forms.
- 6.) Pets will be admitted and discharged **ONLY** during regular office hours.
- 7.) Any pet that requires emergency or immediate veterinary attention will receive it our discretion, and at the **owner's expense**.
- 8.) **Please leave a phone number that we are able to reach you on- incase of an emergency!**
- 9.) All pets must be free of fleas and ticks when admitted for boarding, or it will be treated when dropped off at the **owner's expense**.
- 10.) When picking up your pet from boarding, please be aware of the following issues:
 - *Be aware that your pet's diet may have varied slightly from home, possibly causing G.I disturbances.
 - *Unless you have dropped off your pet's food with them, we will be feeding them Purina E/N (a specially crafted food to be gentle on your pet's stomach)
 - *Your pet could have been in the "incubation period" of some infectious disease when brought to the clinic for boarding. Signs of disease do not develop for several days after exposure to an infectious agent. Even though you assume your pet is healthy it is impossible to detect many problems until your pet starts to show clinical signs. Any changes in the normal routines of your pet can result in "stress". Any form of stress can weaken an animal's immune system allowing some hidden disease it has been incubating to become apparent resulting in a sick pet.
